

# Virtual Education Contract

Dear Parent(s),

Your child is enrolled in a Virtual Education Course this school year. The Birchwood School District has paid the tuition, fee, etc. for your child to participate in this learning opportunity. It is the district's expectation that your child earns a passing grade in this course or pay tuition reimbursement if he/she receives a failing grade.

The Virtual Education Policy states;

**If a student receives a failing grade (in a course for which the district has paid tuition, fees, etc.) he/she (and/or parents) shall be responsible for all costs related to this course. Payment must be received prior to graduation or the taking of any other Virtual Education classes, whether paid by the district or not. Failing a course or not completing a course shall be considered in the approval process for future requests to take virtual courses. Students who have not reimbursed the district are not eligible for future Virtual Education Program participation, until full payment is made.**

For your child to participate in a Virtual Education Course this contract must be signed by both the parent and student and returned to the school counselor.
