1) Skilled Labor Shortage Scholarship - \$2,500 - 6 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be planning to attend a community college, technical institute, or university during the 2019-2020 academic year to study anything from construction management, plumbing or carpentry to landscape architecture or interior design.

B) Be 18 or older and a U.S. resident.

2) John Wright Memorial Scholarship - \$5,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: March 15, 2019)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be an entering or returning student at an accredited undergraduate institution in the United States

B) Be planning on pursuing a career in the commercial arboriculture industry

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- B) Be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

- B) Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and submit an answer to the essay question prior to the submission deadline.
